

WHAT IS TO BE ASKED ?

Architecture and Urbanism Beyond COVID19

:Open Call for Collaborative Research and Proposal

1. Aim and Direction

We see the norms of living together and looking back at the source of architecture and city in a daily life as the time of COVID19 pass by.

Mankind experienced in many of the great plagues and have emptied city but have life recovered persistently. What was the process like and how would COVID19 be different in this hyper-connected era?

Although future is more uncertain compared to other times, we should gather the anticipatory predictions and imaginations from vast number of people and use as compass to guide. Each one of us should draw a map of imaginary future together by gathering pieces that one observe calmly, record and reflect on the gap between built city and lived city in one's resident city.

In this Open Call, we hope to build a platform for public debate that jointly respond to urbanism and architectural crises through new questions rather than immediate solutions, cooperation rather than competition and open processes rather than results.

2. Open Call Detailed Guidelines

1) Host: Seoul Hall of Urbanism & Architecture

2) Type: International Open Call

3) Language

- Korean/English
- Submitted documents should be written in either Korean or English. It should be written clearly and not causing problem in interpretation and translation of regulations, guidelines, queries and other documents.

4) Eligibility

- Individual or up to three members joint application

- Professionals, researchers and students related in architecture, urbanism and landscape architecture
- Professionals and researchers from various fields whom have influence on architecture, urbanism(big data, health care, medical care, disaster prevention, facilities, etc.) can participate in joint application with architecture, urbanism and landscape architecture related professionals and researchers
- Open Call member and concerned parties in other open calls are not allowed to participate in the Open Call.

6) Registration

- Participation Registration: beyondcovid19-opencall.org

7) [Key Concepts] Standards

- Submission: Principally, no changes are allowed after submission on Open Call Platform
- Submission work
 - Registration Application Form: fill in the application form and then register on Open Call website
 - [Key Concepts] submission: Free form arrangement of graphics and text to be included in 10–15 pages of A4 size paper, uploaded in PDF format
- *Mandatory contents to be included:
 - One main image (2400x2400 pixel, 300dpi)
 - Korean max. 200 words, English max. 150 words
 - Collaboration between various fields is encouraged
 - We encourage active collaboration between different fields
 - Participants to submit proof to verify participant's qualification upon [Key Concepts] submission

8) Note

- Number of [Key Concepts] Submission is limited to one per participant.
- Participant is responsible for portrait rights and copyrights in own submission work.
- In case of plagiarism of other works and names, will be excluded from

selection process, abolishment of application and return of any supports that comes with selection (certificate, research funding)

- Copyright of submitted proposal belongs to participant, publishing right and the right of usage belongs to Seoul Metropolitan Government in the case of public interest purposes.

3. Operation Detailed Guidelines

1) Questions posted by participants

- Answer posted by host
 - Open Call Committee in Seoul HOUR will respond collectively and announce on WTA Platform on 8 September (Tue).

2) Selection Process

- Open Call Committee consists of professionals in related fields.
- Open Call Committee select 5 teams which develop their topics into [Research & Proposal].

3) Open Call Committee

- Open Call Committee – 5 members + Preliminary Open Call Committee member

[Operation of Open Call Committee]

- Participation of Open Call Committee member and Preliminary Open Call Committee member
- Open Call Committee will disclose written comments regarding selection result.

4) [Key Concepts] Submission

- WTA platform is open for everyone. All platform participants to submit questions, related architectural/ city observation image, #keyword related to COVID19 situation in their resident city.
- Participants who respond to [Research & Proposal] in the Open Call,

other participants or interested citizens can communicate by information sharing discussion on topics and cooperative networking, and through these actions to develop and submit [Key Concepts].

5) [Research & Proposal] Commission

- The selected [Key Concepts] individuals or teams will be assigned to individual discussion board and to communicate with various participants on the platform and publish their result by developing the topic in [Research & Proposal].
 - The 5 selected [Research & Proposal] will be awarded with 50% of total prize reward of ₩50,000,000 Korean Won once being selected. When [Research & Proposal] result is submitted, the remaining of 50% prize reward will be awarded upon Open Call Committee's evaluation.
 - In the case of insufficient number of submitted [Research & Proposal] match with Open Call's objective, Open Call Committee may select no more than 5 proposals to proceed onto [Research & Proposal] Commission.
 - If the case of selected team gives up or due to disqualification reason, host has the negotiation right to the next runner-up.
 - Contract is to be signed with host. Contract signing shall be within two weeks from result announcement date.
 - Research funding is inclusive of all copyright fees, tax and all kinds of handing fees, in the case of joint application, research funding shall be given to team representative.
